1.	Initial Notice: 7 Day – Demand for Possession for Non-Payment of Rent, or;
	30 Day – Notice to Quit
If they fail to	comply with your request to pay or to vacate in the time allowed then you must move

2.	Obtain forms for filing along with the original notice filled out: Fill out Proof of service at bottom of Notice, and
	Bring Original with copies for each party plus yourself
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3.	Calendar: The dates you will be able to file your complaint with the court
	For the 7 day notice not before the:  8 <sup>th</sup> day
	For the 30 day notice not before the: 31st day
4.	Summons and Complaint Completely filled out with copies for all parties

	Copies: The original plus a copy for the plaintiff and each defendant listed in the complaint and for the officer to serve;
	Lease: Bring a copy of the lease for the Court;
	Envelopes: A <u>self-addressed stamped</u> envelope for the plaintiff if submitting your pleading by mail, a <u>stamped addressed</u> <u>envelope to each defendant</u> to be served.
	(The Court requires that the clerk do a mailing to each defendant, and that an officer serve either personally or by tacking w/proof to court .)
	Court Filing Fees may be paid by cash, check, money order or credit card. Make the check/money order <u>payable to Grosse Pointe Park Municipal Court</u> . Contact the Court for correct amount of filing fees
	You can elect to pursue just possession or just a money judgment but if you are going to pursue possession and a money judgment you must pay that at the time of the filing.
	Process of Service: The Court requires that all Landlord/Tenant complaints be served by a court officer. There is a service fee for the officer and you must have a separate check for the officer. Check with the civil clerk for the officer assigned for service of your complaint.
