SUBJECT: WAIVER OF JURISDICTION OVER CIVIL INFRACTIONS

Pursuant to MCL 712A.2e, the Third Judicial Circuit Court and the Grosse Pointe Park Municipal Court enter into the following AGREEMENT:

1. The Third Judicial Circuit Court waives jurisdiction over all civil infractions alleged to have been committed by juveniles within the geographic jurisdiction of the Grosse Pointe Park Municipal Court.
2. Upon execution of this AGREEMENT, the Grosse Pointe Park Municipal Court has jurisdiction over the juvenile in the same manner as if an adult had committed the civil infraction.

Copies of this ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER and AGREEMENT shall be provided to all affected law enforcement agencies. This ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER and AGREEMENT shall be effective July 1, 1999. Any modifications shall be provided to the State Court Administrative Office.
